1. Health:

- Ms. Frankie Lynch Director of Primary Care PCT will be coming to talk about proposed local health reforms

2. Finance

- It was requested by AD that a brief update of local crimes be included in all public meetings. This will include attempted burglaries and other crimes that may not be reflected in the official crime statistics.
